### Message form the Chief Editor

The first quarter of the financial year was mainly the preparatory session for upcoming trainings of the Institute for rest of the year.

Residential capacity of NSTIAM has increased to 152 with introduction of one new Hostel building (Hostel building 2) during this year. ### **Demo-Lab Setup**

Job for setting up of **one Demo-lab in the Main Building** of NSTIAM under RKVY 2017-18 scheme has completed during April'21. This lab shall be **utilized for demonstration of production of different food products and processed foods** to the intended trainees of NSTIAM under different training programs conducted by the Institute. There are **more than 30 machines and equipment** to demonstrate different processing and preservation processes to the fellow trainees.

Due to this, the trainees may not be required to move to different training cum production centers under the Directorate of Agricultural Marketing, which shall save a considerable time and money required for their travel.

# **Setting up of Online training Studio**

In order to provide agri-marketing knowledge, skills and supports to the farm families, maintaining physical distancing under this fluctuating economic condition caused due to the present Global pandemic by COVID19, NSTIAM has setup **one online studio during June'21.** 

NSTIAM has planned to conduct several trainings on **Post-harvest Management, e-NAM, e-Permit, Marketing Management etc.** using this online platform.

Members of several **FPO, FPC, Farmers group, traders, ex-trainees** and individual farmer shall be the target groups of these 2 days to 10 days training programs.
