Induction Training Course under State Budget-2022-23

For the first time, NSTIAM conducted a 2-Weeks Induction Training Course for the Newly Recruited Officials of Directorate of Agricultural Marketing from 06th June to 18th June 2022. Total 19 officers from Directorate of Agricultural Marketing, as nominated by Director of Agricultural Marketing, West Bengal took part in the program. Among them, eight (8) Agricultural Marketing Officer (Training & Canning) and six (6) Assistant Agricultural Marketing Officer (admin) were new to this Department. Five (5) Assistant Agricultural Marketing Officer (admin), who were recently promoted to their posts, also took part in the training program.

Different aspects related to Departmental activities, Tendering process, Acts and rules enacted by the Department, Basic roles and responsibilities as a Government Official and as DDO were covered in this program in addition to dedicated interactive sessions on IFMS, HRMS and WBHS.

Visit to **Sufal Bangla Hub** at Singur Krishak Bazar, **Cold Storage** and hands-on practical in the **Demo Lab** of NSTIAM were also part of the training. The program was concluded with beautiful group presentations by the trainees followed by distribution of participation certificate by **Chief Executive Officer**, **West Bengal State Agricultural Marketing Board**.



In the directory, one can find the district wise database of the Farmer Produce Companies of the State along with their address, contact details, company registration details, activities and member status.
